AMSTERDAM, NETHERLANDS - Day 1: Monday, June 24, 2024



Take a boat ride along Amsterdam's charming canals past sturdy old houses and under quaint bridges. Visit one of the city's superb museums housing many of the Dutch Masters' most outstanding works, or learn about Anne Frank and the city's Jewish heritage. Journey into the countryside and see historic windmills and the fascinating porcelain works in Delft.

ANTWERP, BELGIUM - Day 2-3: Tuesday - Wednesday, June 25-26, 2024



The two most recurring sights in Antwerp are the works of local sculptor Peter Paul Rubens and hands, which adorn everything from the town flag to the local Belgian chocolates. The hands' symbolism is explained at Brabo Fountain in Grote Market Square, which depicts the soldier that severed the hand of a mythical giant who bullied the townspeople by taking tolls. Antwerp is also known for its beautifully preserved Gothic and Baroque architecture, which includes the Cathedral of Our Lady, a masterpiece of lace work in stone on Groenplaats public square.

PARIS (LE HAVRE), FRANCE - Day 4: Thursday, June 27, 2024



Enjoy the scenic trip through the rolling French countryside to Paris and spend the day savoring it's gardens, museums and historic sites. Visit the Louvre, Notre Dame and the Eiffel Tower. Take a boat ride along the Seine and a stroll along the Champs Elysee. Or visit historic Rouen or the battlefields of Normandy.

LONDON (PORTSMOUTH), UK - Day 5: Friday, June 28, 2024



Surveying the chaotic web of London's streets – over 600 square miles of them – it seems as though none of them lead out of the city. And why would they, as everything you could want is here, from castles to cathedrals and paintings to parks. Human history unfolds at the unrivaled British Museum, while residents and visitors opine at Hyde Park's Speakers' Corner. Find world-class theater in London's West End and a parade of history's greatest artists in any one of its art museums. For explorations in Portsmouth, take your pick of maritime heritage attractions: three historic ships, a submarine and several top museums such as The D-Day Story and the National Museum of the Royal Navy.



ST.PETER PORT (GUERNSEY), UK - Day 6: Saturday, June 28, 2024



Enjoy this charming port, its beautiful harbor, architecture and imposing castle. See the rugged countryside and take a walk along the extraordinary cliffs and down to the sea, where Renoir once admired the view. Or savor the landscape in a drive around the island past grazing Guernsey cows in rich pastures. Then visit artisans working with silver and gold. Learn about the German occupation during WWII, or tour Victor Hugo's house and absorb the spectacular view. Stroll through the lovely Candie Gardens on this island known for its flowers.

CORK (COBH), IRELAND - Day 7: Sunday, June 29, 2024



Cheerful Cork sprawls about the River Lee in one of Ireland's most stunning settings. Bridges crisscross the city leading to landmarks like St. Anne's Church and the Old City Gaol, where you'll see the 19th century prisoners' graffiti. Make time to kiss the Blarney Stone in Blarney Castle.

DUBLIN, IRELAND - Day 8: Monday, June 30, 2024



Considering it's the birthplace of some of the world's greatest literary figures – Beckett, Joyce, Shaw, Wilde, Yeats – you can't help but wonder what it is about Dublin that so inspires. Exploring the city, you find answers. It's the strong sense of community embodied in its pub culture, in the stunning churches seemingly on every corner, and in the sprawling parks where residents gather to commune with nature. It's also the history preserved in the ancient books of Trinity College's Old Library and in the story of Guinness and his iconic beer.

GLASGOW (GREENOCK), UK – Day 9: Tuesday, July 1, 2024



Offering some of the finest Victorian architecture in the UK, Glasgow is a major center of commerce and culture. Glasgow Cathedral is one of the only cathedrals in Scotland to have survived the Reformation intact and houses a celebrated collection of stained glass windows. The Burrell Collection showcases a range of work by major artists such as Rodin, Degas and Cézanne, as well as examples of late medieval, Chinese and Islamic art. When exploring Scotland's culinary culture, be sure to taste some of the famed single malt whiskies.



CRUISING THE NORTH SEA – Day 10: Wednesday, July 2, 2024

STAVANGER, NORWAY – Day 11: Thursday, July 3, 2024



Chosen as the European Capital of Culture in 2008, Stavanger lies in southwestern Norway's stunning fjord region. Old Stavanger has been meticulously preserved with many of its wooden cottages converted into art galleries and boutiques. But it's the museums that set this cosmopolitan city apart. The Stavanger Museum alone consists of eight buildings exhibiting collections that include maritime, medical and printing artifacts. Outdoor enthusiasts may enjoy walking the nature trails along the banks of nearby Lysefjorden, a classic fjord, or beholding the amazing view of the countryside from Pulpit Rock.

ARENDAL, NORWAY – Day 12: Friday, July 4, 2024



Weave through a constellation of picturesque isles and discover quaint Arendal, which drapes over the verdant hills lining the mouth of the Nidelva River. Stroll the stone-paved streets of the enchanting Old Town, where flower-bedecked wooden homes are painted in crisp white or vivid crimson. The town's proud fishing heritage is on display at the fascinating Brattekleiv Shipyard, which has been maintained exactly as it appeared in 1876. On lush Merdø Island, explore a historic farmhouse that offers a glimpse into rural 18th-century life. Despite its unassuming size, Arendal hosts acclaimed exhibits of contemporary art at the Bomuldsfabriken Kunsthall.

OSLO, NORWAY – Day 13: Saturday, July 5, 2024



Overlooking a gorgeous fjord, Norway's capital and largest city simply radiates with natural beauty and sophistication. Oslo's rich seafaring history is on display at the Viking Ships Museum, rivaled only by the Kon-Tiki Museum, which holds the balsawood raft that Norwegian adventurer Thor Heyerdahl used to sail from Peru to Polynesia. History aside, Oslo exudes a love of the outdoors in city parks like Vigeland, which is adorned with over 200 life-size sculptures by artist Gustav Vigeland. Much of Oslo is heavily forested with pines, making it one of Europe's greenest cities.
